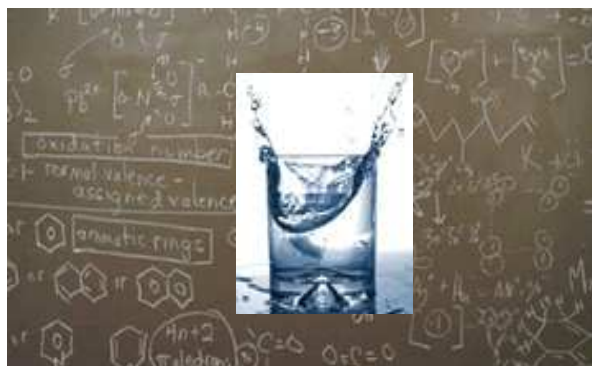


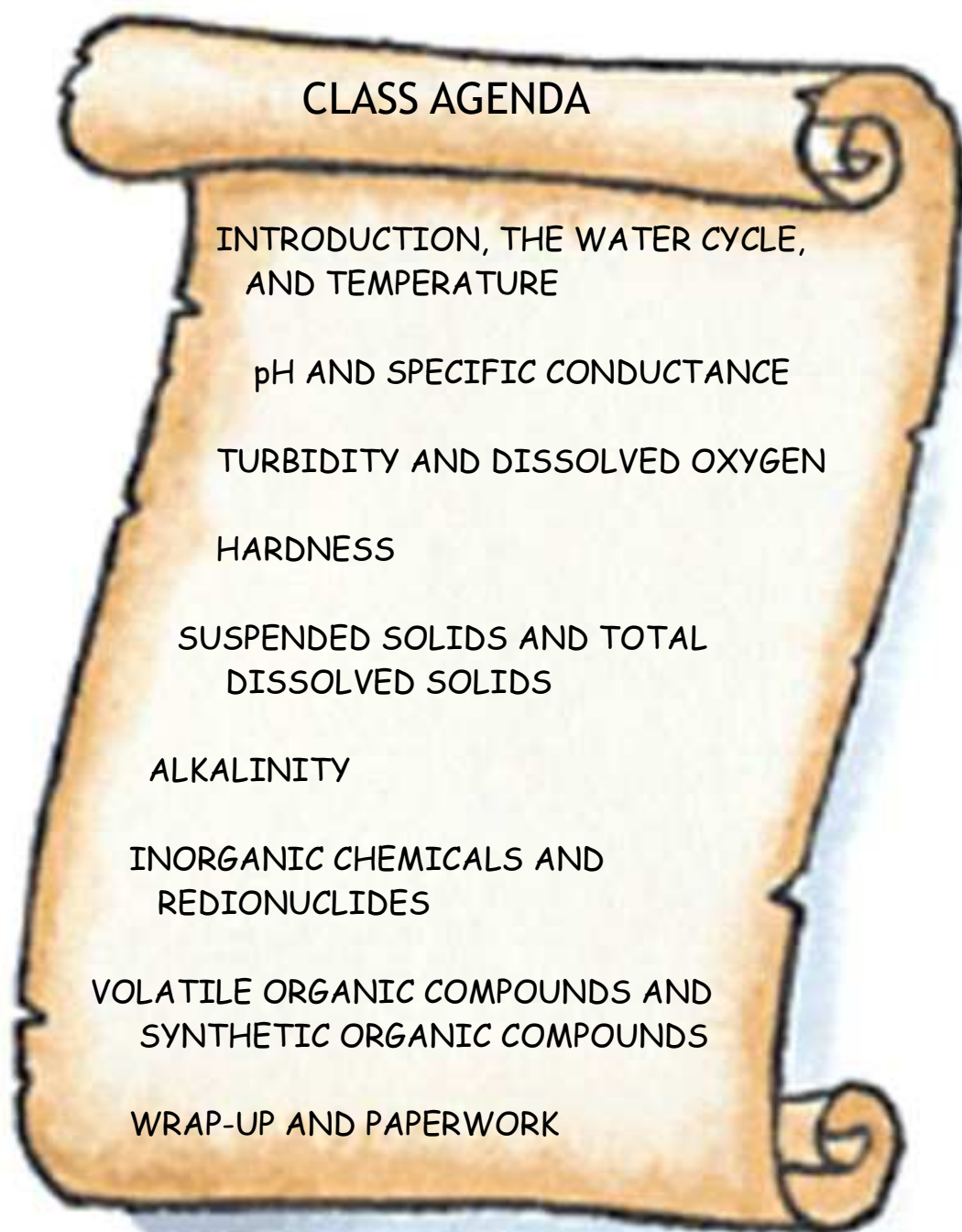
# BASIC DRINKING WATER CHEMISTRY CLASS
