

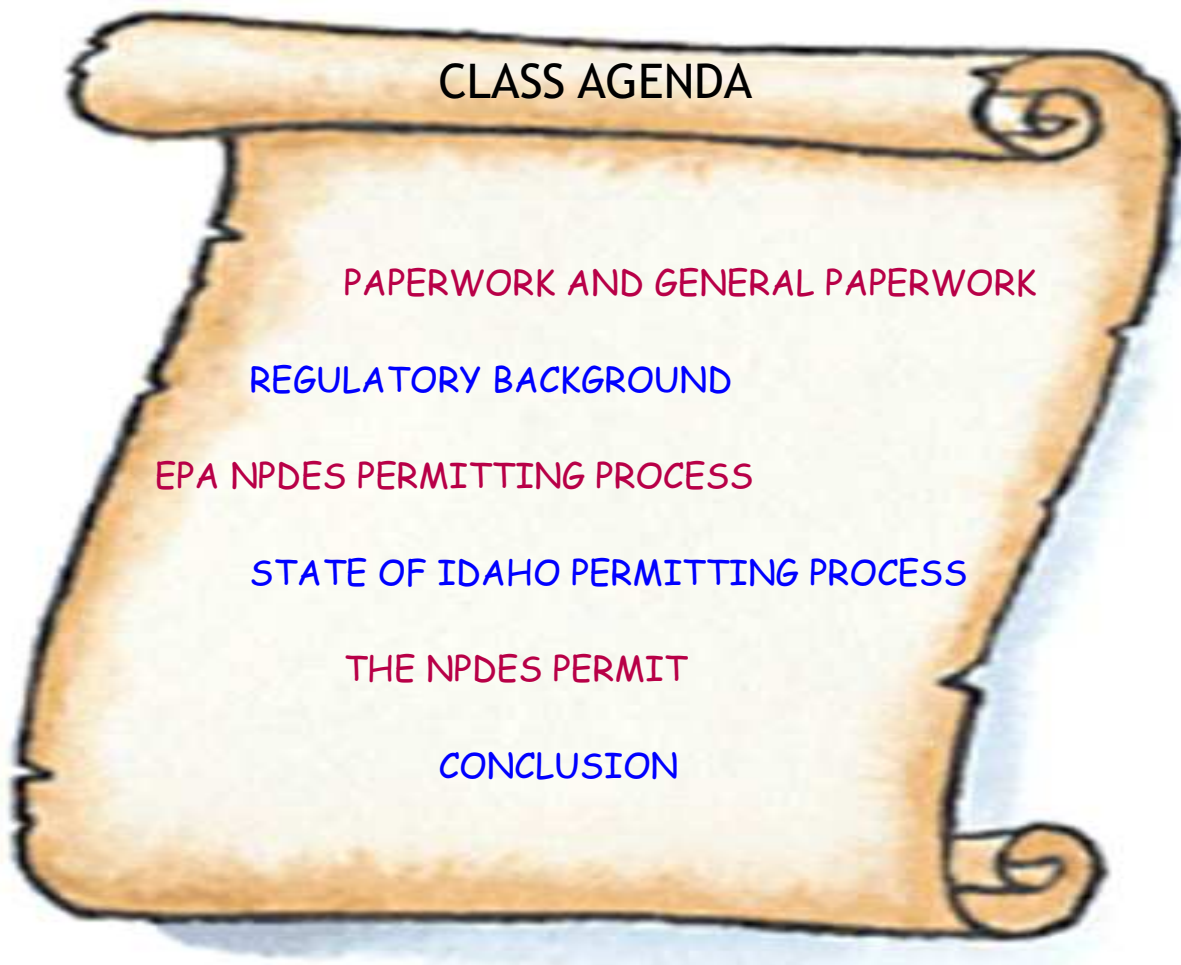
NPDES PERMIT DEVELOPMENT IN IDAHO
